



## **Commercial Waste Disposal Policy**

Frampton Garage have a cooperate responsibility to ensure that all waste is disposed of correctly and economically, to ensure that waste is kept to a minimum and to ensure that it is stored correctly and securely. Frampton Garage are compliant with all legalities regarding waste storage and disposal.

### **Responsibilities**

- To minimalize the amount of waste by prevention, re-using, recycling and recovering waste.
- To ensure that the waste is stored correctly and securely.
- To ensure that waste is disposed of correctly.

### **What is business waste?**

Any waste that comes from a commercial activity is business waste. If you use part of your home to run your business, then any waste from that part is business waste.

Business waste also includes any waste that comes from:

- construction
- demolition
- industry
- agriculture

### **Minimalizing waste**

Frampton Garage endeavour to keep waste to a minimum daily and following this all waste is monitored for recycling and reusing purposes. Any excess waste is taken away by an authorised, independent waste disposable company who are responsible for sorting the waste into various recycling categories.

### **Storing waste**

All waste kept at Frampton Garage is stored safely and securely on site until disposed of. Waste oil is kept in containers separate to new oil containers to avoid contamination.

### **Waste Oil**

There are on site containers for waste oil. The waste oil is taken away regularly by an authorised waste oil management company who are responsible for disposing of the waste correctly.

### **New oil**

All new and unused oils are kept in containers on site and sit above a secondary container in case of leaks. All new oils are kept in separate containers to avoid contamination. All new oils are labelled correctly.

### **Waste Batteries**

Batteries are taken by an independent company who restore and re-use old batteries. Batteries that cannot be re-used are recycled for materials.

### **Waste Vehicles and parts.**

Any vehicles that are left at Frampton Garage for scrap purposes are recycled for spare parts and materials. All parts are recycled for materials. Parts can be cleaned, reconditioned and re-sold and this can be carried out by an independent company.

No parts are re-used, cleaned or re-conditioned for re-sale by Frampton Garage unless the customer has been made aware and have given their consent for reconditioned parts to be used when repairing their vehicle. Some parts are sent back to suppliers under surcharge conditions. For example; engines are sent to suppliers upon receiving a new engine to be repaired and reconditioned ready for resale by the supplier, the purpose of this is to minimalize waste and to reduce costs for future use when selling used parts for repairs.
